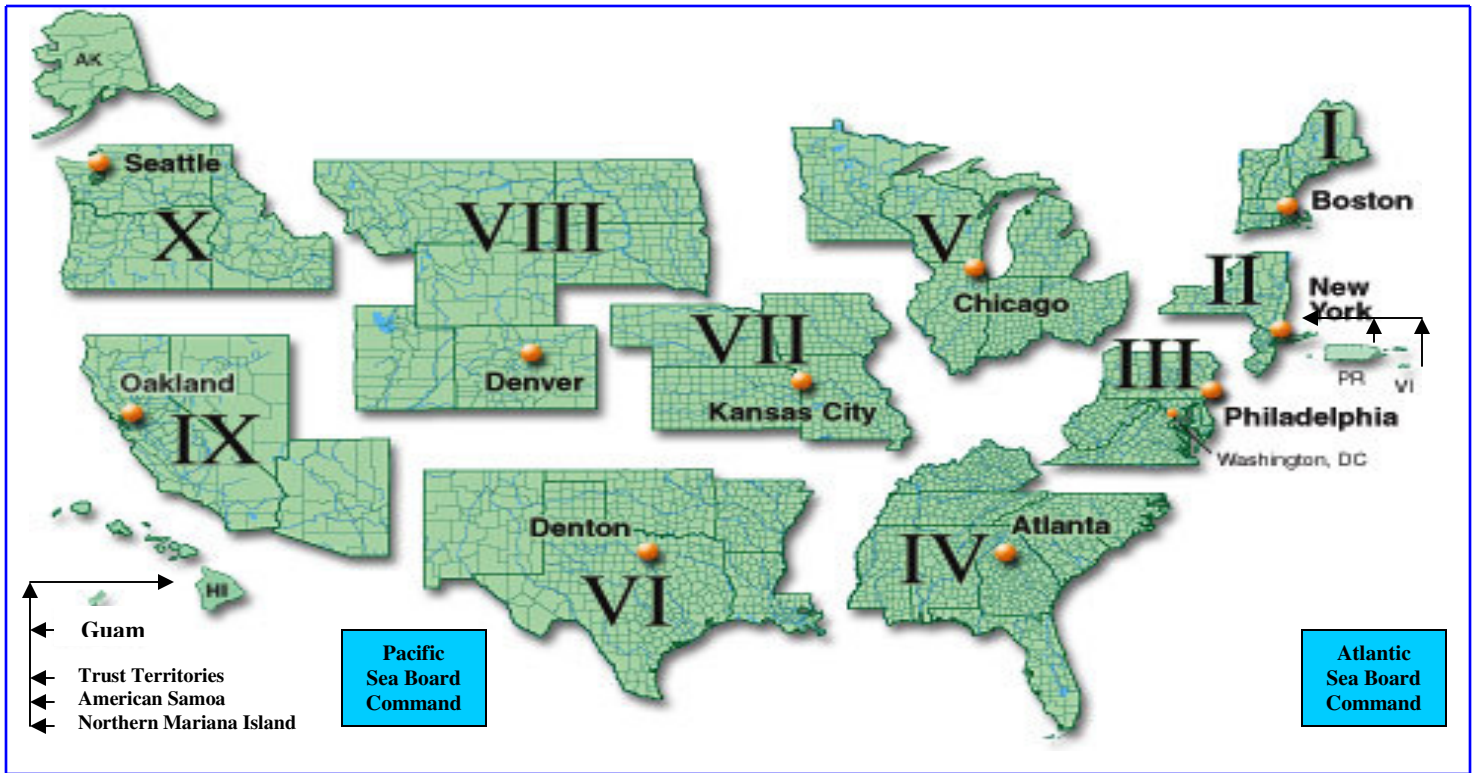

## Introduction to Governor's Mobile Tactical Command

The staff of Governor's Mobile Tactical Command, Inc. would like to thank you for giving us the opportunity to share our Mobile Tactical Command Newsletters! We welcome you to our second year of publication designed to assist the leaders of our country.

We have designed a powerful and productive Mobile Tactical Command Unit to be utilized at any ground zero or other high profile location. In the past few weeks several leaders have asked us how they can help. (Funding) Our research is clear as this newsletter will inform government officials of this model and others to come.

Twenty-six issues ago we initially established and defined standard operating procedures and protocols for each of the 38 responding units. We have added two additional concepts which will enhance the documentation process and better defined the components assigned to the unit. This makes the person assigned to the unit more accountable during and after a state of Emergency.

Each command leader assigned to the unit will submit a comprehensive report within ten business days of arriving back at the regional command location. Along with this report, the other members of the team will be required to submit suggestions to enhance the unit standard operating procedures or protocols. Each member assigned to the unit will submit a summary of their accomplishments at ground zero.

By identifying and addressing the responsibilities of each member of the unit, will be strengthening the system. There are a total of 20 questions which will require answers after a state of Emergency.

1. **Concept-** Identify any changes needed to better the team
2. **Responsibility -** Identify any changes for each member of the team
3. **Functionality-** Identify any changes to enhance the task of the team
4. What can we do to improve the over all command headquarters utilizing this unit?
5. Where, What, When, Why, and How can we make Governor's Command better and stronger.

These questions will be addressed by each command leader and staff. There are a total of 38 different responding units which make up **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters**. Our research team has spent countless hours developing **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** for ground zero applications.

We have identified the need for ten different mobile tactical commands across America. We will address the special equipment that is needed in each of those regions in up-coming meetings.

## The essentials of how Governor's Mobile Tactical Command is Deployed

Once the Governor declares a state of Emergency in the affected state, the **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Units** will be dispatched to a location to be determined while en-route.

1. **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** is a 100% functional Command structure! We will first activate our radios and audio-video links through our secure servers and to our website for complete connectivity.
2. **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** will link to Command Central Control, at which time our units will be able to talk freely and provide the audio and video images to any field command associated with G.M.T.C. Headquarters at ground zero.
3. **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** will have the ability to move hundreds of sick and injured individuals, by ground, to a safe area for food, medical or dental attention and treatment, or to a safe haven.

## How the state Emergency Operation Center interacts with Governor's Command

When a Governor declares a state of Emergency in his or her state, our 38 responding units have 36 to 48 hours to establish **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters**. Our Goal is to arrive at Ground Zero, if extenuating factors are not an issue within this time frame.

When **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** is notified by the Governors office, F.E.M.A., or Homeland Security, we will dispatch our standard five **Subject Matter Experts** (Fire/EMS/Utilities/E.O.C. and a Public Safety Officer). If the Governor would like different S.M.E's to arrive at the state E.O.C., they may at their discretion, request a specialist. We have compiled a list of S.M.E's such as scientists, chemists, biologists and biochemists to name just a few. Our standard five **Subject Matter Experts** will be flown to the state E.O.C. Headquarters where the declaration of emergency originated.

Our portable communication network has been designed to travel in any airplane. We will secure our computer command network while on board for our S.M.E's. Our S.M.E's will begin assisting the leaders and commanders inside the state E.O.C. Once **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** is 100 percent operational our Subject Matter Experts will be transferred to **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** at ground zero. We will accelerate the movement of our personnel into the affected area and establish communications between **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters**, our own **Central Control Command**, local command and state E.O.C. Command

Our command airplane will become the focal point for the Governor to review videos of the affected area while flying into the area of concern. The Governor will be able to communicate with staff, executive branch leaders and ground units. All videos will then be transferred to our secure website for review by the responding director, **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** and **Control Central Command**. Local authorities will also be able to review prior to the arrival of the Governor and his/her staff.

**Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** is a self sufficient independent command unit utilized at ground zero. **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** will assist and place trained individuals in a community where the manpower is needed most. All first responders, volunteers or other workers who come through **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** will complete several documents and submit information, through the computer, regarding their health and next of kin.

The computer systems will be located at **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters**, satellite locations and staging areas. Each worker, paid or volunteer, will be required to register at any one of these command locations. After completing the registration form the individual will place their thumb/finger into a finger print analyzer, for clearance from the FBI or Homeland Security Office. First responders, volunteers and other workers will be assigned to a command center task force inside ground zero.

Each worker will be required to wear their G.P.S. identification tag at all times. If the assigned workforce member inside ground zero becomes sick or hurt, all they have to do is activate their G.P.S. locator button on their G.P.S. identification card, or if they do not return to local command by the expected time, **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** or **Control Central Command** will activate the G.P.S. locator chip on their identification card.

If a major accident occurs inside the affective area we can activate the Global Positioning Systems locator chip on each identification card independently. This will identify the last location of injured individuals.

We have designed and patented a Red, White and Blue Hologram G.P.S. identification card and a G.P.S. bumper sticker which will monitor military personnel units, volunteers, first responders, police, fire vehicles or any other support vehicles registered through **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters**. We will be able to identify and rescue individuals in a building collapse by utilizing the patented G.P.S. system which is a key component to the command structure.

The **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** employs 30 different command sectors to control infrastructure divisions. In addition, 5 command units will assist in the movement of vehicles and products inside the affected area.

## Creating the Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Round Table

### **We will identify Governor's Mobile Tactical Command**

1. The first meeting is in **Orlando, Florida on July 21 – 22, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will create a task force of experts to form a round table. The maximum number of experts from each state should not exceed two.

### **We will identify the impact of having Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters established in each region and will generate over **118** new jobs**

2. The second meeting is in **Atlanta, Georgia on August 25 – 26, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will have the necessary information to establish specific commands for each region and their location.

---

### **We will identify the topography and address special needs and how our equipment will be shuttled by land, sea or air to the affected area of ground zero**

3. The third meeting is in **Saint Louis, Missouri, on September 22 and 23, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will finalize a list of all special equipment needed for each specific region.

---

### **The direction and scope of establishing Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters will be better identified and defined by the fourth meeting**

4. The fourth meeting – is in **Washington, D.C, on October 20 and 21, 2007**. We will invite specific Associations, Organizations, Special interested parties and private groups to help offset the cost of networking and to establish the first **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters**.

If each state pays their initial share by the fourth meeting and we generate **\$25,000,000.00** in donations from the private sector each state will only pay ONE MILLION DOLLARS THE NEXT YEAR (if the donation from the private sector continues). If we receive more donations than originally pledged, the states will offset the cost difference the following years! By acting today, the first completed **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Units** could be on-line by mid spring of 2008.
