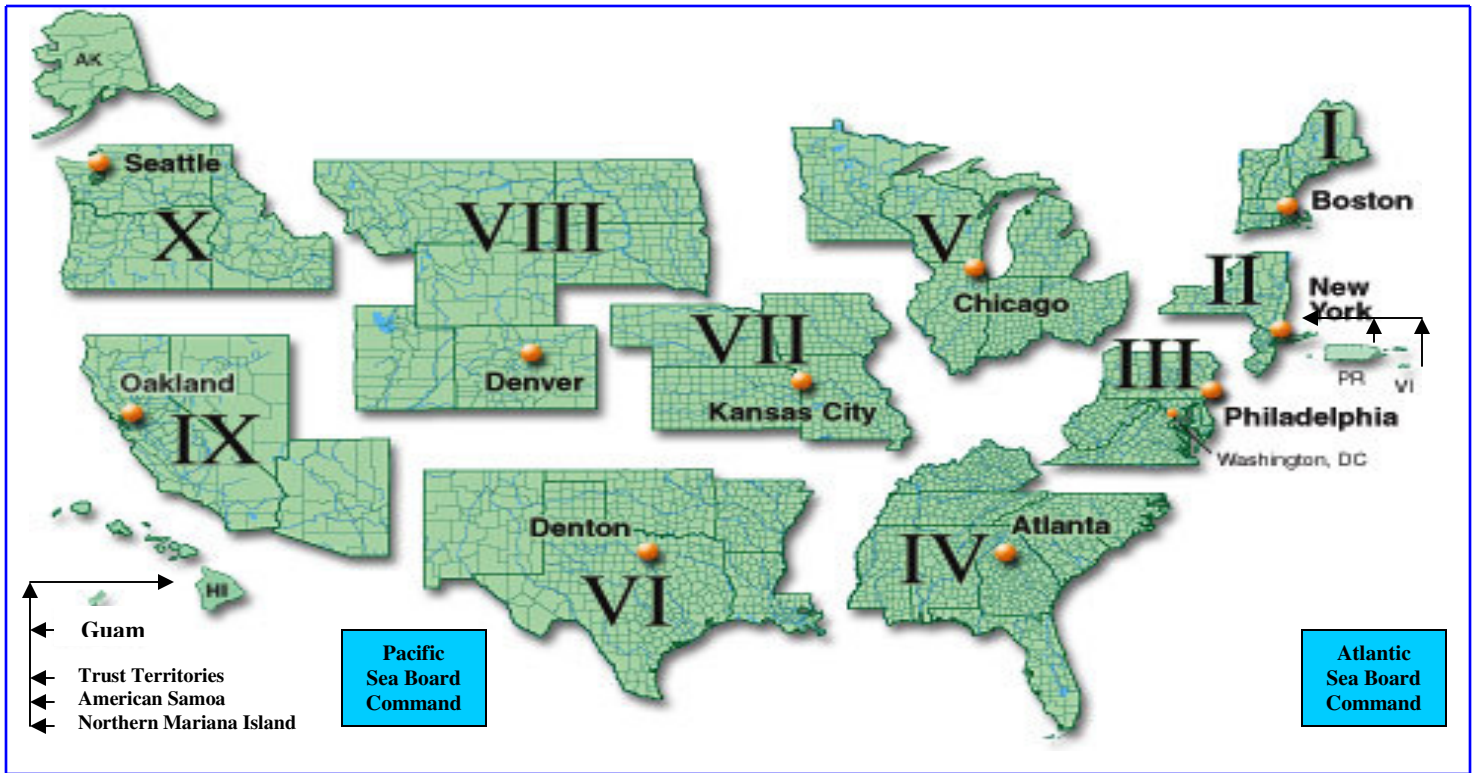

We have established the fuel protocols before leaving and after arriving at ground zero. The gasoline company will arrive to refuel our tanks every other day. Every Governor Command unit deployed into ground zero will be inspected daily, refueled and placed back into full response status by the next morning so the command officers can deploy the unit to the most needed area.

1. Chevrolet will provide an emergency mechanic response team. Each command unit will have a complete daily electronic diagnostic test to detect possible break-downs. This diagnostic testing procedure will be done by Chevrolet mechanics at an in house garage unit. These special mechanics will work around the clock to keep the units up and running at 100 percent efficiency.
2. Motorola or Verizon will provide an emergency communication response unit to keep the telephone network up and running 100 percent.

3. Michelin or Goodyear tires will provide an emergency garage response unit to help keep our units up and running at 100 percent.
4. Pepsi or Coca-Cola distributors along with the water company will have a member assigned to kitchen command during operation hours.
5. Whoever we decide to purchase our fuel from B/P, Sunoco or Texaco will keep our units and our fuel depots full and maintained during the state of Emergency,
6. Caterpillar Corporation will provide an emergency mechanical garage response unit to help keep our units up and running at 100 percent efficiency. They will work with the Chevrolet garage and have independent mechanics for the tractors and other equipment.
7. All response units and support vehicles and equipment will use synthetic oil. Nitrogen will be added to each tire.

Protocols have been written to address equipment and replacement parts for **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command** units only. U.P.S. and or Federal Express will move the necessary items/equipment to the closest open airport to ground zero.

Governor's Mobile Tactical Command helicopter or ground unit will be dispatched to the landing zone to pick-up the items/equipment necessary to get units back in service. Needed our own airplane can be utilized to pick up the equipment. The turn around for ordering new equipment or replacement parts is less than 10 hours from the initial call. We have networked with Fortune 1,000 companies to have one manufacture supply depot open 24 hours a day during a state of Emergency. These locations are outside the affective region.

Staging Requirements

Our staging requirements are straight forward! There will be 2 – 2,500 gallon diesel tanks and one 1,000 gallon unleaded tank for refueling purposes. If we need to refill our fuel tanks daily, one of the above fuel companies will have the contract. These tanks are transported empty then filled at staging for command and outside responding agencies. Fire, Police, Utilities, Military and other support equipment. These tanks are separate from **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters**.

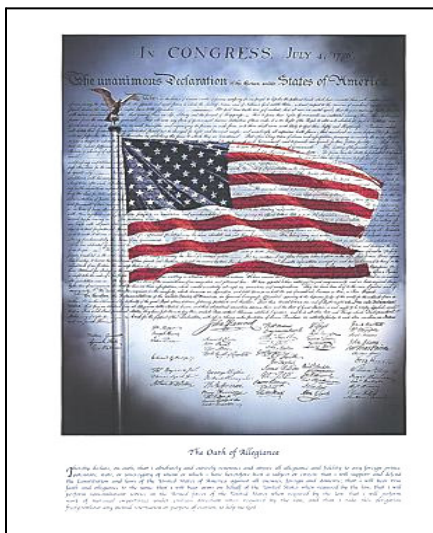
Governor's Mobile Tactical Command provides staging officers who are in contact with Governor's Command at all times. Governor's Command will advise our staging officers of needed equipment and manpower in a given area. The Staging Officer will notify Governor's Command of the units and team personnel sent into ground zero. Governor's Command will send the names and team units to the Sector Commander who will be waiting for the arrival of the staging personnel. Once the members are at Sector Command, they will notify **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** to up-date the command system. This will inform our leaders that all members have arrived and are officially assigned to specific Sector Command. Once the Sector Command is finished with the equipment and personnel, the information will be sent back to Governor's Command who will notify Staging Command so they can wait for the arrival of the team. The command system automatically updates without verbal response. This allows for a true tracking system within the arena. All personnel will be required to sign in and obtain a Governor's Command G.P.S. identification card and a G.P.S. Bumper Sticker for monitoring purposes. Each staging area will have the following;

1. Hot and cold food available from Kitchen Command
2. Separate bathroom facilities for men and women
3. Separate showers for men and women
4. Laundry Mat Unit – This unit will be maintained by in-house laundry staff
5. Large air condition/heat sleeping tents will be provided by a third party company

These units are managed by the governor during a HOMELAND Security Breach and/or Disaster crisis.

These units are managed by the United States President when the national alerting system reaches **RED**.



We have a mobile surgical/dental unit with our own A.L.S. transport helicopter.

We can utilize the equipment at any national convention or government private dignitary functions.

Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters will have a tent city in and around the staging areas which will be able to hold up to 300 first responders. These tents and units are unique in design and will be provided by a third party company. Each unit is air conditioned and heat controlled. The option of having a cot or a sleeping bag will be up to the first responders. There are sleeping quarters, bathrooms and shower facilities for men and women.

During other disasters, free lancing caused significant damage and fraud. **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** is trying to minimize this in the region after a State of Emergency is declared. By educating personnel who arrive at a constituent's home to repair the property, to show the Red - White - Blue Hologram Identification G.P.S. Card, which indicates the member is in good standing and is registered through Governor's Command.

If a constituent complains and gives the name and/or badge number of the problem responder we will activate the Red - White - Blue Hologram Identification G.P.S. Card and remove them from the area. A hot list will be developed for workers who do below standard work and are defrauding constituents.

If an individual goes into an area and no one asks to see the Red - White - Blue Hologram Identification G.P.S. Card, and he does great work, we will never know how to thank him. However, if this same individual is questioned, all he has to do is to go to any local command or travel to the staging area at **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command** to obtain a Red - White - Blue Hologram Identification G.P.S. Card.

Once the emergency is over the Red - White - Blue Hologram Identification G.P.S. Card and our G.P.S. bumper sticker will be deactivated. However, if the units or management teams would like us to continue to monitor their vehicles, a small charge will be assigned by one of our sister companies for a 24 hour monitoring system. The Hologram Identification Card and our G.P.S. bumper sticker will be deactivated and used as a souvenir.

Creating the Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Round Table

We will identify Governor's Mobile Tactical Command

1. The first meeting is in **Orlando, Florida on July 21 – 22, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will create a task force of experts to form a round table. The maximum number of experts from each state should not exceed two.

We will identify the impact of having Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters established in each region and will generate over **118 new jobs**

2. The second meeting is in **Atlanta, Georgia on August 25 – 26, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will have the necessary information to establish specific commands for each region and their location.

We will identify the topography and address special needs and how our equipment will be able to be shuttled by land, sea or air to the affective area of ground zero

3. The third meeting is in **Saint Louis Missouri, on September 22 and 23, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will finalize a list of all special equipment needed for each specific region.

The direction and scope of establishing Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters will be better identified and defined by the fourth meeting

4. The fourth meeting – is in **Washington D.C, on October 20 and 21, 2007**. We will invite specific Associations, Organizations, Special interested parties and private groups to help offset the cost of networking and to establish the first **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters**.

If each state pays their initial share by the fourth meeting and we generate **\$25,000,000.00** in donations from the private sector each state will only pay ONE MILLION DOLLARS THE NEXT YEAR (if the donation from the private sector continues). If we receive more donations then originally pledged, the states will off set-the cost difference the following years! By acting today, the first completed **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Units** could be on-line by mid spring of 2008.
