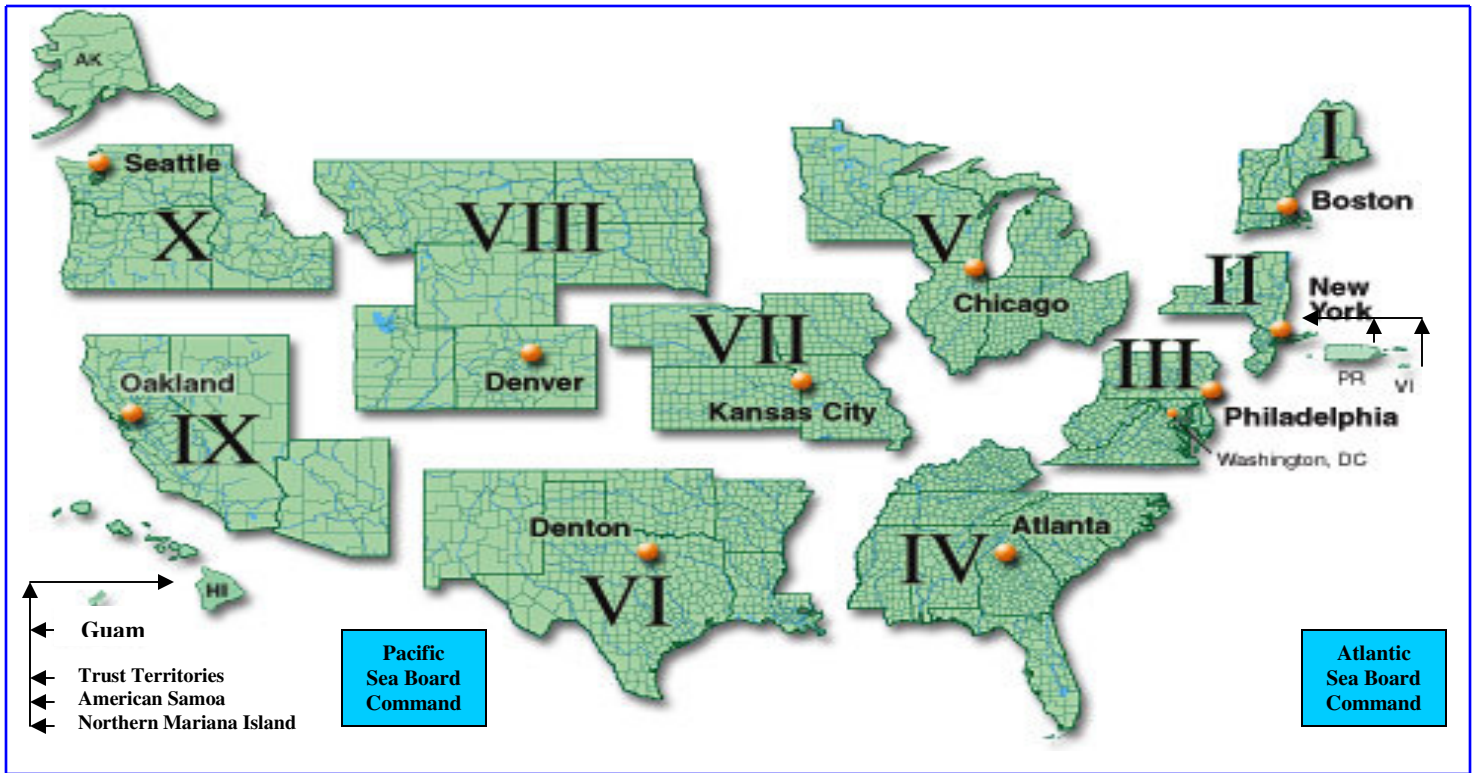

Why we are establishing the first Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters in The State of Tennessee

Initially, we established Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters in Central Florida. Due to logistical problems such as travel miles and time distance, we elected to house Governor's Mobile Tactical Command in Region IV. After talking to City Council Members, Mayors and Gubernatorial Staff across Region IV, we decided to establish the first National Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters in Tennessee.

Governor's Mobile Tactical Command and Command Control Center is in full motion. On December 14, 2006, we engaged in purchasing 67.7 acres of land for a cost of \$1.125 million. The location of this prime land is in a community which will provide quality employees. Our research and census information have indicated the availability of people we are looking for in the area.

The land is located in a secluded area of the Smokey Mountains which includes 214 feet of waterfront on the Tennessee River. This will provide the needed resources to develop the portable electrical power unit to run Governor's Command and to test other equipment such as our Jet Ski fire boats and people movers.

- A. **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command** is located three miles from a train depot where our units can be placed on a train and moved around the country. We are currently addressing Amtrak, CSX and other railroad systems to minimize our response times. We are located between two major cities where Military C-5 airplanes can pick our units up and transport them to the affected area.
- B. **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command** is located within 45 minutes of two Metropolitan Airports.
- C. Traveling North, South, East or West, from our new location in Tennessee, we can cover more than three quarters of the country in 24 hours.

Once the units arrive at ground zero and are together, the computer technicians will set up each computer command area. There are 25 computers which will operate independently to assist local commands. Ten additional computer systems are inside the communication center which is attached to the north canopy.

Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters has state of the art computer and support technology. We have shared some technical and vital information with you regarding how the units are transformed into Mobile Tactical Command Units.

When **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Units** become a reality, we will visit Mayors, City officials, Governor's and Executive Branch Leaders and their staff. We will discuss how **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters** will respond to any crisis in their state. We have developed a College for our Subject Matter Experts and a Mobile Tactical Command Training School.

The Governor will control the Emergency Management Center and the 25 local tactical command units utilized at ground zero. Within five hours after arriving at ground zero, **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command** should be up and running at 100 percent efficiency. We are a self-sufficient unit for two weeks.

We will be able to feed over 500 emergency workers per day with Kitchen Command once it is established at ground zero. The Kitchen Field Command (K. F. C.'s) will be supported by Nicole's Kitchen from the C.C.C.

Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters has secured radios, V.P.N. systems, established up/down links to a secure satellite, and will be able to set up the local 911 and Reverse 911, ARES ® systems if necessary. We have the network and capabilities to manage the movement of Air, Land and Sea units through our radar systems.

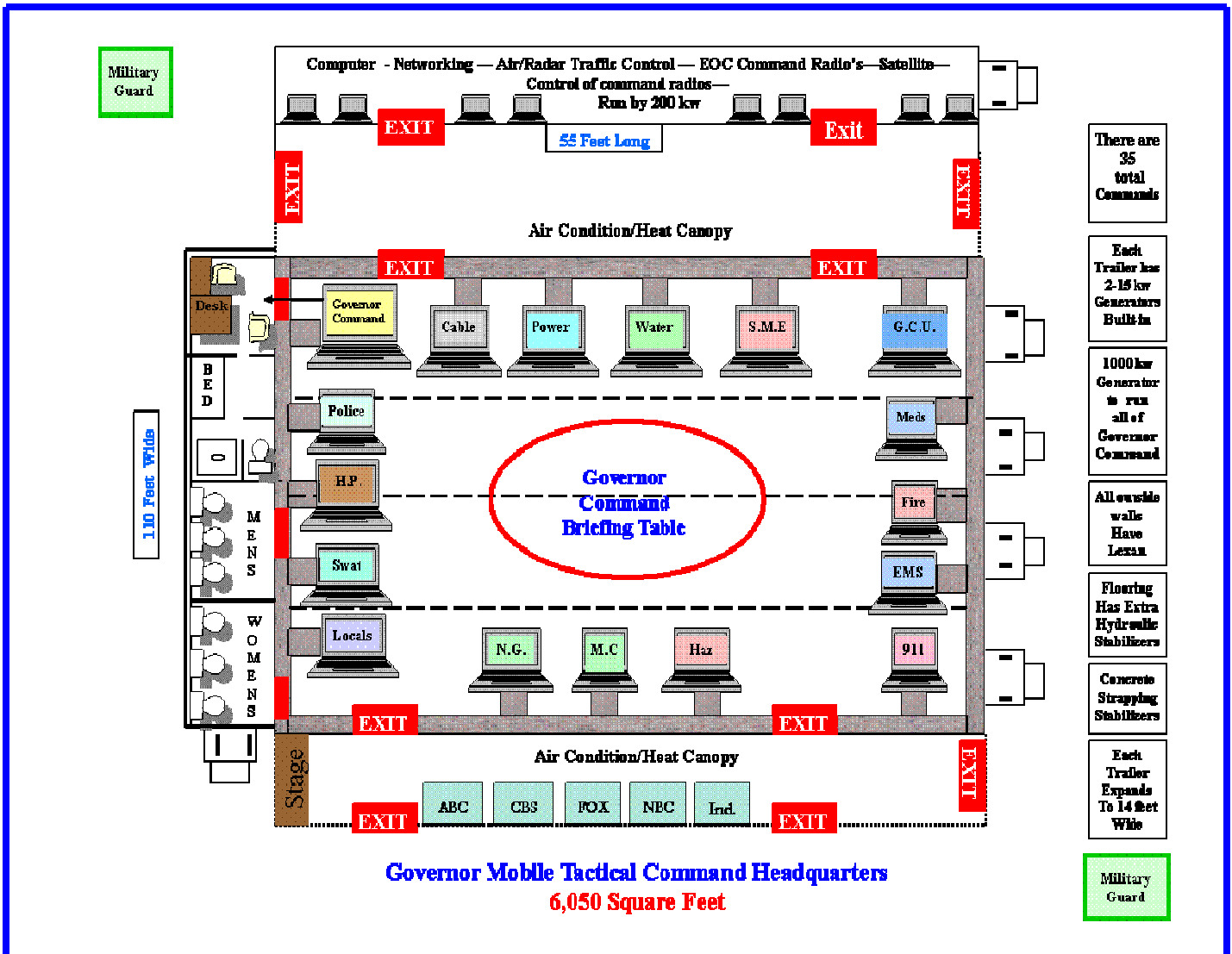
Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters at ground zero will be tied down by heavy web strapping. The web strapping will run over the units and be secured by spikes which are driven four feet into the ground by pneumatic jets. The heavy web strapping is designed to minimize wind damage to the roof and keeping the units tied together.

The C-8500s have their own independent back up generators which produce 40 Kw per unit. **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command** main generator is a 1,000 Kw power unit. The second 1,000 Kw power generator units are designed for staging and tent city.

Introducing a National Hazardous Material Team Associated with G.M.T.C.

We are in the planning stages of developing a National Hazardous Material Team. The current State Hazardous Material Teams will be able to expand their level of expertise to a national level. Developing a national team today will reduce deaths and injuries to American citizens and unit personnel.

The National HazMat Team will have their own equipment, vehicles and nationally certified Hazardous Material Team members who will work closely with our S.M.E's. We will introduce our Scientists, Biologists, Chemists and Biochemists through our computer secured network or by face-to-face meetings.

Our commanders will monitor and utilize other Hazardous Material Teams across the nation and will be able to link and give their supporting teams the necessary resources at a National Level.

The network will be open to any local or state Hazardous Material agency that needs rapid information during a local Hazardous Material incident.

We will provide a 24 hour Hazardous Material response team and information center. Our plans are to assist local, state and national agencies.

Creating the Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Round Table

We will identify Governor's Mobile Tactical Command

1. The first meeting is in **Orlando, Florida on July 21 – 22, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will create a task force of experts to form a round table. The maximum number of experts from each state should not exceed two.

We will identify the impact of having Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters established in each region and will generate over **118 new jobs**

2. The second meeting is in **Atlanta, Georgia on August 25 – 26, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will have the necessary information to establish specific commands for each region and their location.

We will identify the topography and address special needs and how our equipment will be able to be shuttled by land, sea or air to the affected area of ground zero

3. The third meeting is in **Saint Louis Missouri, on September 22 and 23, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will finalize a list of all special equipment needed for each specific region.

The direction and scope of establishing Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters will be better identified and defined by the fourth meeting

4. The fourth meeting – is in **Washington D.C, on October 20 and 21, 2007**. We will invite specific Associations, Organizations, Special interested parties and private groups to help offset the cost of networking and to establish the first **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters**.

If each state pays their initial share by the fourth meeting and we generate **\$25,000,000.00** in donations from the private sector each state will only pay ONE MILLION DOLLARS THE NEXT YEAR (if the donation from the private sector continues). If we receive more donations than originally pledged, the states will offset the cost difference the following years! By acting today, the first completed **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Units** could be on-line by mid spring of 2008.
