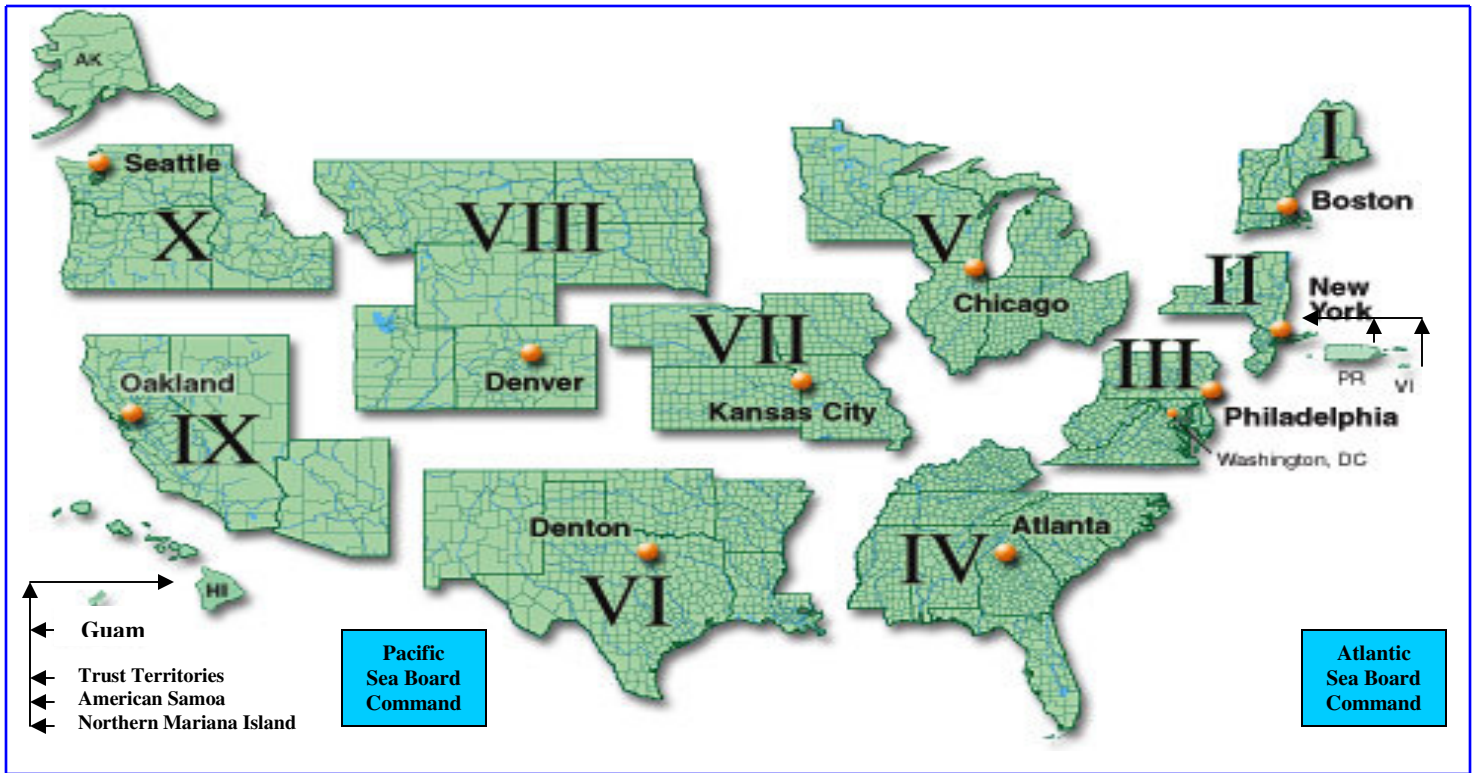

The next hurricane season came and devastated the Gulf Coast region. We saw first hand the City of New Orleans infrastructure collapse and the devastation of hundreds of other neighboring communities and states that needed additional assistance.

Now imagine multiple major cities across the region affected by a natural disaster or home land security breach. By having strategically placed Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Units in 10 Regions across America, we will be able to control the movement of teams, personnel and equipment by establishing standards from one city to another.

The horrific stories from the media, reading behind the scene reports from fire, police and electrical magazines just did me in. I personally e-mailed the President of the United States twice and suggested ideas.

During the aftermath my son went to Mississippi with his company and was sad to report his findings. My wife and his girlfriend were summoned to Mississippi to be by his side during the long trip home. My wife was devastated by what she saw. Once our family was home safely, she shared with me what impact the trip had on her. As she cried, I told my wife I was working on a project to monitor first responders in a ground zero arena and to evenly distribute the first responders to all effected regions.

Well two years of research and commitment and thousands of hours has produced *Governor's Mobile Tactical Command* as we know it today. This charter newsletter is the first formal publication of its kind to inform the communities at large.

I would like to personally thank all the mechanical, electrical and structural engineers, mayors, city officials, state and Federal agencies and to my friends who have encouraged me to continue the design of *Governor's Mobile Tactical Command* and to my children and my wife I thank you for your support.

The research has been extensive and that is why we are going to start a new college known as: The College of Field Command and Operation.

We are introducing the first Technology and Research Conference of its kind for Subject Matter Experts.

We are going to start the first round table conference for Subject Matter Experts.

We are going to establish TEN Regional *Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters* across America.

Why we are establishing the first *Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters* in the State of Tennessee.

“Hence the concept”

Initially, we established *Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters* in Central Florida. Due to the logistical problems (such as travel miles and time distance), we elected to house *Governor's Mobile Tactical Command* in Region IV. After talking to City Council Members, Mayors and Governor Staff across Region IV, we elected to establish the first National *Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters* in Tennessee.

“Hence the concept”

Governor's Mobile Tactical Command is in full motion. On December 14, 2006, we engaged in purchasing 67.7 acres of land for a cost of \$1.1 Million dollars. The location of this prime land is in a community which will provide quality people. Our research and census information have given us the range of people we are looking for in the area.

The land is located in a secluded area of the Smokey Mountains which includes 214 feet of waterfront on the Tennessee River. This will provide the needed resources to develop the portable electrical power unit to run Governor's Command and to test other equipment such as our Jet Ski fire boats and people movers.

Governor's Mobile Tactical Command is located three miles from a train depot where our units can be placed on a train and moved around the country. We are currently addressing Amtrak, CSX and other railroad systems to minimize our response times.

Governor's Mobile Tactical Command is located within 45 minutes of two major Metropolitan Airports where Military C-5 airplanes can pick our units up and transport them to affected areas.

Traveling North, South, East or West from our new location, within 24 hours we can cover more than three quarters of this country.

The story line will continue to grow and with your help so will the model.

Hiring an in-house National Real Estate Agent

One of the first employees we hired, and a bold decision, was to have an in-house real estate agent who works as a Realtor through a national real estate company. Our Board of Directors has agreed to hire this individual. In future months our Realtor will be sent to countless communities across America to develop new locations in seven different regions and finalize the purchasing arrangements with our attorney's.

Her team will consist of a staff of four employees. Her initial job is to finalize the acquisition of 66.5 acres of land in Tennessee on the Tennessee River. The cost of this great location is One Million dollars. Our goal is to have seven unique Governor's Mobile Tactical Command centers throughout the country.

This department will be given the responsibilities to build all of our outside storage buildings and additional outsourcing buildings for our future stores and printing and publishing company.

This department will find land and secure the land for our College of Field Command and Operations as well as land for our sister companies. Her department has a strict line item and land budget. We are looking forward to expand this department as soon as we can.

Creating the Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Round Table

We will identify Governor's Mobile Tactical Command

1. The first meeting is in **Orlando, Florida on July 21 – 22, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will create a task force of experts to form a round table. The maximum number of experts from each state should not exceed two.

We will identify the impact of having Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters established in each region and will generate over **118 new jobs**

2. The second meeting is in **Atlanta, Georgia on August 25 – 26, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will have the necessary information to establish specific commands for each region and their location.

We will identify the topography and address special needs and how our equipment will be able to be shuttled by land, sea or air to the affective area of ground zero

3. The third meeting is in **Saint Louis Missouri, on September 22 and 23, 2007**, (RSVP) – We will finalize a list of all special equipment needed for each specific region.
-

The direction and scope of establishing Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters will be better identified and defined by the fourth meeting

4. The fourth meeting – is in **Washington D.C, on October 20 and 21, 2007**. We will invite specific Associations, Organizations, Special interested parties and private groups to help offset the cost of networking and to establish the first **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Headquarters**.

If each state pays their initial share by the fourth meeting and we generate **\$25,000,000.00** in donations from the private sector each state will only pay ONE MILLION DOLLARS THE NEXT YEAR (if the donation from the private sector continues). If we receive more donations then originally pledged, the states will off set-the cost difference the following years! By acting today, the first completed **Governor's Mobile Tactical Command Units** could be on-line by mid spring of 2008.
